ICAO ASSEMBLY ELECTS ECAC¹MEMBER STATES FRANCE, GERMANY, IRELAND, ITALY, SPAIN, SWEDEN, TURKEY and UNITED KINGDOM TO JOIN ICAO COUNCIL FOR THREE-YEAR TERM

Montreal, 4 October 2016 — The 39^{th} Session of the Assembly of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) completed the election of its new Council today.

Eight out of the 36 seats of the Council are allocated to Europe, with the following Member States of the European Civil Aviation Conference (ECAC) elected:

- FRANCE,
- GERMANY
- IRELAND (representing the ABIS Rotation Group²),
- ITALY
- SPAIN
- SWEDEN (representing the NORDICAO Rotation Group²)
- TURKEY (representing the BSCG Rotation Group²)
- UNITED KINGDOM
